Selection Methodology

The 2026 Top 25 Leaders of Impact honorees were selected through a structured review process supported by an internal selection committee representing multiple business functions. Candidates were evaluated using a weighted methodology that considered career tenure, discipline experience, level of leadership responsibility, executive and officer-level scope, multi-functional management experience, education and continuous learning, board and community service, measurable workplace and/or community impact, and nomination or recommendation letters. Each candidate completed an application and submitted impact statements demonstrating leadership excellence, commitment to inclusion, development of others, and sustained contribution to business and community outcomes.
